

The Central Fire Department is hiring a Training Officer! This is a full-time, civil service position. This is a competitive position; therefore, applications are welcome from outside of the Central Fire Department. Application will be accepted from December 14, 2020 until December 29, 2020 at 11:00am.

Qualifications for the position are as follows:

UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED, ALL QUALIFICATIONS MUST BE MET PRIOR TO SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION.

- Valid Driver's License
- Must possess one of the following either a high school diploma, high school equivalency certificate, or college degree.
- Five (5) years full-time experience with a paid fire department or two (2) years full-time service in fire service training.
- At a minimum, the applicant must also possess the following certifications as per NFPA standards:
 - Hazardous Materials Operations
 - Firefighter II
 - Driver/Operator – Pumper
 - Instructor II
 - Fire Officer II
 - Fire Inspector I
- Prior to confirmation in class, applicant must obtain certifications as both a CPR instructor and EMT instructor.

Additional information:

- This will be a straight-day position, working Monday-Friday.
- A departmental unit and office will be provided for this position.
- The Training Officer position will hold the rank of District Chief and be paid accordingly.
 - The pay scale is \$44,800 – \$69,797, depending on experience.
