

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING TO CONSIDER  
ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION CALLING FOR AN  
ELECTION TO RENEW AD VALOREM TAX MILLAGES**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that on Tuesday, May 10, 2022 at 6:00 o'clock p.m., the Board of Commissioners of Central Fire Protection District No. 4 ("the District") will consider the adoption of a resolution calling for an election on November 8, 2022 at which time tax millage propositions would be submitted to the voters of the District , including propositions to renew/extend for an additional ten years: (1) a 10.0 mill *ad valorem* tax for development, operation and maintenance of the Fire District and paying the costs of obtaining water for fire protection purposes, including charges for fire hydrant rentals and service; and, (2) a 4.25 mill *ad valorem* tax for salaries, retirement, benefits and related expenses. This public meeting has been properly announced and will be held at the District's headquarters, which are located at 11646 Sullivan Road, Central, Louisiana, 70818. This notice is being given pursuant to La. R.S. 42:19.1 and all other applicable statutes and authorities.
